School Day

Reminder: our school day starts at 08:45 and ends at 15:15, for all classes. Learning starts with reading and phonics so every minute counts... please be on time. Late charges apply for anyone not collected on time after 15:15.

<u>Uniform</u>

Everyone looked so smart in their new uniforms – just a reminder that this includes:

- Nursery to Year 5 a red sweatshirt; Year 6 a black sweatshirt;
- a white polo shirt only;
- black/grey trousers or skirt and black shoes.
- we also continue to have strict guidance around the wearing of jewellery. Small studs only to be worn, no necklaces/rings or smart watches these will be confiscated until the end of the day.
- all long hair MUST be tied up appropriately for the duration of the school day.
- PE kits must include a white T-shirt, black shorts and suitable footwear. Tracksuits may be brought to go over the PE kit, in the colder weather.

<u>Swimming</u>

Starting next week (Thursday 14th September) Years 4-6 will go swimming. Y4 and 5 will attend Salford University Leisure Centre and Year 6 will attend East Manchester Leisure Centre. Separate letters will be sent out containing full details of these sessions.



Extracurricular After School Clubs

These clubs start next week, Monday 11th September. For this half term, all of these clubs will be **free of charge** (excludes Night Owls). If your child attends Night Owls and you would like them to join in one of our extracurricular clubs while they are here, you must still book onto the club, using School Spider. As always, there are limited places available – this will be different for each club. If all places have been allocated, you will not be able to complete this process. <u>Please note: bookings will open Wednesday 6th September at 09:00 and will close on Monday 11th September at 12:00 noon. No bookings can be made before or <u>after these times.</u></u>

How to Access Club Bookings

To access the clubs available to your child, you will need to select '**Bookings & Payments'** on the dashboard menu.



Add the 'product' to your basket.



You will then be asked to checkout your purchase. This will take you to the payment section, where you will be asked for card details like any other online purchase you might make (no payment needed for Autumn 1 but follow the same process of booking).

School Spider is our **only** platform for parent communication and payments, including: After School Club bookings; Night owls and Early Bird club bookings; school uniform purchases; event/trip contributions; parents' evening appointments and school dinners.

In order to access these features and receive all relevant and often urgent communication from school, **please download the School Spider app**, which is available in both the iTunes store and Google Play. If you are unable to download the app, you are still able to access the parent platform by logging in through the school website, <u>https://www.abbott.manchester.sch.uk/</u>.

All parents should already have a log in for the website, associated with the email provided to school. Once downloaded, you will be able to log in to the app and request a password reminder. Please note, **the username is NOT your email address**. If you are unsure of your username and/or password, select 'Forgot Password'. If you are new to the school, or have never previously logged into the parent platform on our school website, you will have to set up an account through the app.
